

1. Purpose

This policy sets out the framework for charging fees for events and filming activities taking place on public land, heritage sites, or council-managed venues. It ensures that pricing is consistent, transparent, and aligned council policy.

2. Objectives

- Ensure fair and consistent pricing for all users.
- Generate income to support the maintenance and enhancement of public spaces.
- Encourage high-quality, inclusive and sustainable events and productions.
- Minimise disruption to residents, businesses, and the environment.

3. Scope

Applies to supporting and facilitating events in relation to:

- Commercial and community events (e.g. festivals, markets, performances)
- Filming and photography (e.g. TV, film, advertising, influencer content)
- Use of council-owned land, buildings, and heritage assets

4. Pricing Structure

5. Additional Charges (see T&Cs):

- **Admin Fees:** Amendment after the permit has been issued.
- **Site Supervision:** Charged if council staff are required on-site @ officer's hourly rate
- **Clean-up/Damage Deposit:** Refundable, based on post site assessment
- **Late Applications:** May incur an admin surcharge of 20%
- **Extra Licenses:** Cherry Pickers etc £50-£200
- **Amendment prior to the issuing of a Permit** – additional 50% of the permit application fee.
- **Amendment following the issuing of a Permit** – additional 75% of the permit application fee.

6. Payment Terms / Payment Methods:

- The permit application fees (Table 1) are applicable from the time an application is submitted.
- Payment terms and methods are included on the invoice. Invoices include an IN number, which must be referenced.

7. Review and Governance

- Fees reviewed annually and in line with Council process.
- Oversight by the Service Manager.
- Stakeholder consultation will inform any significant changes to price increases.

8. Communication

- All fees published on the council website.
- Clear guidance provided during the application process.

9. Cancellation

Events -

- Organisers giving more than 4 weeks' notice will be issued a full refund of the licence fee.
- Less than 2 weeks notice will be issued 75%.
- 1 weeks notice a 50% refund will be issued.
- Less than 1 week will be subject to a 100% cancellation fee.
- Other fees will be dependant on external factors.

Filming –

- Please read the pricing schedule for details relating to non-refundable items*

- A cancellation fee of 50% of the total sum owed is payable (once a permit is issued) if more than 48 hours' notice is provided before the shoot start time.
- If less than 48 hours' notice is given in writing, the full sum is payable.

**We know that filming and event requirements can change regularly and at short notice, and we will do our utmost to ensure flexibility. However, depending on the application, costs may have been incurred that will need to be covered, we will endeavour to inform you of these as soon as possible.*
